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## 2.1 Advantages of Blended Learning for Teachers

- Teaching is less expensive to deliver
- Blended learning offers flexibility in terms of availability
- It is more affordable and saves time
- In other words, eLearning enables the student to access the materials from anywhere at any time

- Access to global resources and materials that meet the students' level of knowledge and interest.
- Self-pacing for slow or quick learners reduces stress, increases satisfaction and information retention.

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## 2.2 Advantages of Blended Learning for adult learners

Increase learner's interest:

When technology is integrated learners are more likely to be interested in, focused on, and excited about the subjects they are studying.
