Project Video Documentary

FIPL propose a "three prong" attack for the video documentary. We propose to focus on three distinct areas of the project:

- 1. Transnational Training Event
- 2. Local Perspective
- 3. Final Conference





1. Transnational Training Event - IT

- Worthwhile to show outsiders as it is one of the best elements of any project
- Easy to disseminate as a stand alone piece or as part of a bigger production – For example – full project documentary
- The training overall was a success so it is worthy of promotion





2. Local Perspective

- Important to promote as this is a real indication of the project as a whole
- Interesting for partners to get a sense of feedback from other partner countries.
- Impact on NGOs from COVID will be an interesting motif.
- Again, as a standalone piece it would be interesting and easy to disseminate.



3. Final Conference

- Always worthwhile to film the Final Conference as the main dissemination event and the only one all partners can be a part of at the same time
- Interesting to get views from keynote speakers.
- Final Conference is a big event and is worthy of filming.





What does FIPL need from partners?

- 1. Transnational Training Event IT
- FIPL do not need anything form partners for this segment
- Footage has been shot and collated
- Video is currently in production and will be ready by the end of November
- Once ready, partners can share through their social media streams



What does FIPL need from partners?

2. Local Perspectives

- ❖FIPL will require partners to shoot 2 x 2 minute pieces to camera from stakeholder, or anyone involved in the project locally.
- FIPL will provide partners with shooting guidelines, along with sample questions by mid December, if agreed upon.
- FIPL will require partner's by mid March, if agreed upon.
- Final video will be ready mid April





What does FIPL need from partners?

3. Final Conference

- Short, snappy interviews with partners so look pretty!
- FIPL will send film crew to final conference to shoot the day, along with key note speakers.
- Format of this segment is still undecided. Possibly may document the entire journey from Ireland to Paderborn as a (hopefully) post COVD celebration.
