## Introduction:

The training will focus on building a good understanding of the specifics of modern leadership styles. Supporting individuals in discovering and building their own leadership competences will constitute an important element of the training.

Additionally, future leaders will be introduced to the following aspects and challenges associated with social and green entrepreneurship; idea generation, evaluation, testing and prototyping in the NGO sector, and funding opportunities.
