1. Transnational Training Event – Italy

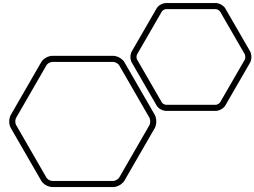
- ❖ This first video provides an overview of a Transnational Training Event that was held in Regio-Emilia, Italy, as a result of the NGEEnvironment project.

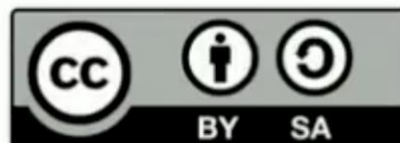
