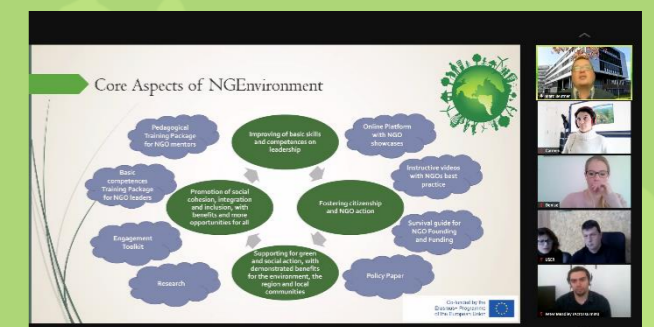
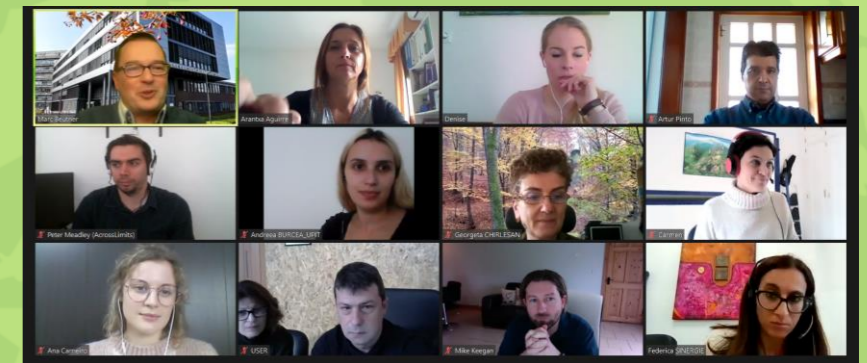

Foster European Active Citizenship and Sustainability Through Ecological Thinking by NGOs

From 24th to 26th of November 2020, representatives from Germany, Portugal, Greece, Malta, Ireland, Italy, Romania and Spain attended the **4th Partner Meeting** of the Erasmus+ project: 'NGEnvironment- Foster European Active Citizenship and Sustainability Through Ecological Thinking by NGOs' (2018-1-DE02-KA204-005014). This meeting took place virtually due to Covid-19.

This online meeting replaced the transnational meeting that should have taken place in Greece. Its main objective was to share information and review the **current state of the project** and especially, of the **Intellectual Outputs (IOs) development**. During the meeting, participants presented the conclusions of the module testing (IO2 and IO3) in their countries, checked the status of the Intellectual Output 6 (IO6), presented the website, the Learning Environment and the working plan for IO7, IO8 and IO9.

Furthermore, the meeting had other goals such as the information exchange about the Covid-19 situation in each country and the discussion of different options to organise next meetings and multiplier events in each country.
