On December 2020, NGEnvironment "Foster European Active Citizenship and Sustainability Through Ecological Thinking by NGOs" (2018-1-DE02-KA204-005014) launched a course for NGO leaders


The course is already **available on the project website** after testing the course materials in Spain and the rest of the partners' countries (Germany, Portugal, Greece, Malta, Ireland, Italy and Romania). It is available, under registration, in all partners' languages.

The objective of the course is to activate talent from citizens that may become NGO leaders for change and sustainability and capacitate them to take action in their communities. The course will then train NGO leaders on topics such as entrepreneurship, sustainability, valuation of natural and social capital, management, leadership and motivation, financial administration, funding, among others. Indirectly, trainees will also acquire a set of basic skills and competences.

## The course is organized in two Intellectual Outputs:
