t Foster European Active Citizenship and Sustainability Through Ecological Thinking by NGOs

The final conference of the Erasmus+ NGEnvironment project (2018-1-DE02-KA204-005014) was held online on 7 and 8 July 2021. More than 100 participants from different stakeholders confirmed their attendance and representatives of the 8 project partners from 8 European countries (Germany, Portugal, Greece, Malta, Ireland, Spain, Italy and Romania) attended the conference.

After the welcome by the project coordinator (University of Paderborn), a presentation of the purpose and objectives of the project took place. Afterwards, the nine Intellectual Outputs (IOs) were presented by the leading partners, one by one, among them the training materials for current and future NGO leaders: IO2 (Induction to Pedagogy for NGO staff) and IO3 (Training package for social and green NGO leadership), as well as IO7 (Survival guide for NGO Founding and Funding).

Other results that were presented are: IO1 (Research report on NGOs), IO4 (best practices), IO5 (Engagement toolkit), IO6 (Audiovisual package), IO8 (Policy paper) and IO9 (Laymans report).
