The project is nearing completion (31 August 2021) and all the results are on time despite the COVID19 pandemic, apart from the translation of the Layman's report. 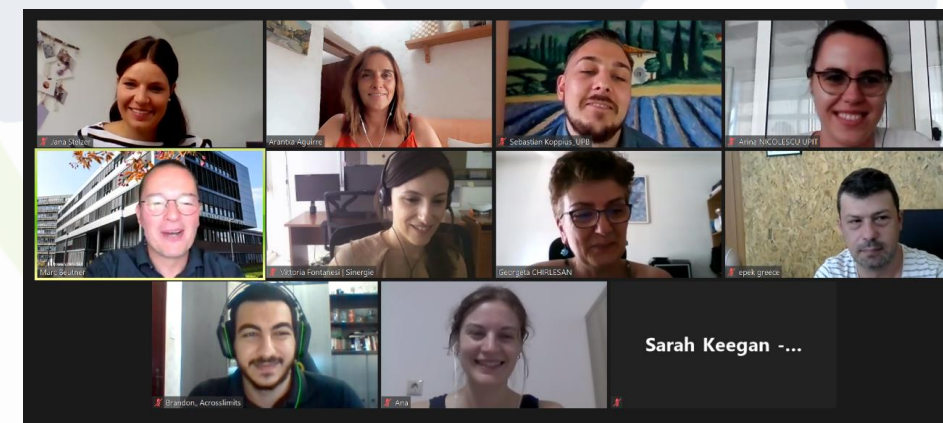
