Insights into the results of the Kick-Off Conference in Lousada about Foster European Active Citizenship and Sustainability Through Ecological Thinking by NGOs (NGEnvironment)

This document shall give an overview of the data collected by using the Conference Evaluation Report of the Kick-Off Conference from the 6th to 7th of November in 2018 of the NGEnvironment project, hosted by Right Challenge in Portugal.
